

# Should I go into Hospice?



## Possible COVID 19 Scenarios and What to Do Updated September 1, 2021

COVID -19 Scenario	You are Fully Vaccinated <sup>1</sup>	You are NOT Fully Vaccinated
1. Have <b>COVID Symptoms</b> including cold or flu symptoms or gastrointestinal type symptoms 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Notify Supervisor/on call</li> <li>Stay Home</li> <li>Obtain Test</li> <li>If test is <b>negative</b>: then return to work when symptom-free for 24 hours (respiratory symptoms<sup>2</sup>) or 48 hours (GI symptoms)</li> <li>If test is <b>positive</b>: then self-isolate 10 days and return to work if symptom free for 24hours (respiratory symptoms) or 48 hours (GI symptoms)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Notify Supervisor/on call</li> <li>Stay Home</li> <li>Obtain Test</li> <li>If test is <b>negative</b>: Isolate for 10 days or as directed by OPH and do not return to work unless symptom free for 24hours (respiratory symptoms) or 48 hours (GI symptoms) and negative test result obtained weekly.</li> <li>If test is <b>positive</b>: Isolate for 10 days or as directed by OPH and do not return to work unless symptom free for 24hours (respiratory symptoms) or 48 hours (GI symptoms). Weekly negative test results will not be required until 90 days post first positive test AND symptom free</li> </ul>
2. You are <b>asymptomatic</b> for COVID symptoms but have been <b>exposed</b> to a person who tested positive for COVID and not wearing appropriate PPE 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Notify supervisor/on call</li> <li>You do not need to self-isolate, but need to closely self-monitor for development of symptoms.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Notify Supervisor/on call</li> <li>Stay Home and self isolate</li> <li>Closely self monitor for development of symptoms</li> <li>Obtain negative test before return to work and continue with weekly testing</li> </ul>
3. You have a <b>household member</b> who is symptomatic for COVID-19 or has tested positive for COVID 19 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Notify supervisor/on call</li> <li>You <b>do not need to self-isolate</b>, but need to closely self-monitor for development of symptoms.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Notify Supervisor/on call</li> <li>Stay Home</li> <li>You are <b>required to self-isolate</b> until the symptomatic individual has received a negative COVID-19 test result or an alternative diagnosis. If testing is not conducted then you must self-isolate for 10 days from last exposure.</li> </ul>

<sup>1</sup> Fully vaccinated means it has been greater than 14 days since your 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of the vaccine

<sup>2</sup> Return to work will be reassessed after 6 days if residual symptoms such as a chronic cough persist but otherwise not ill.
